The way we do Solway Recycling has changed from the 1st January 2026. From this date we will only charge you for the bags when collected from The Tayforth Office (or can be delivered for a flat fee of £5.00). You will not pay for the uplift until this has been completed.

All outstanding bags, before 2026 will be collected as normal as these have been paid for. (This side of the scheme will stay open until the end of 2027 to use up these outstanding bags)
