They can be posted out to you, you can collect them from the office, or we will drop them off to you when passing. This is subject to availability and maximum of two per member.

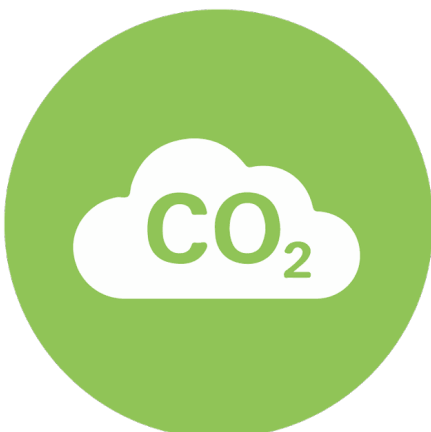
Stock bought & Sold

One of the optional requirements to claim next year's Single Farm Payment is to conduct a Carbon Audit.

If you are interested you would need to cut and uplift as a job lot. Suitable for weaving, fencing etc. Willow is about 3 years old and will be ready to cut in November. 1 mile from Kinross.
