Welcome to the harvest bulletin on a very wet and windy day.

Winter Barley and ORS harvests are almost all completed with reports of average yields of grain and straw. Wheats look slightly ahead of Spring Barley at present with yields still to be confirmed.

Straw prices are currently at £80/t in the bout for Barley and £70/t for Wheat. Please remember to add £20/t for baling, collecting and loading. Please remember that this is only for top class dry product. Damp wheat Hestons for strawing carrots will be worth considerably less. If you wish to market through your Ring we have ample buyers currently for top class round and square straw and can arrange everything from combining, baling, carting, loading and of course the buyer. These prices may vary as the season progresses.

Commodity sourcing of Fuel, Quarry Materials, Concrete & Baling Materials are all at a record volume in 2024 re-enforcing us as the go to place to come to for farm supplies.

Availability


